Doing in class questions helped me, but I believe I would have benefited more at times by just sitting and listening to an instructor teach the material. It's hard to grasp things fully when you are learning solely from pre class videos. Especially when the videos are set up where information is given to you all in one video. I would recommend multiple videos each starting with "teaching" then a practice problem. Many times I had to go to outside resources to get more help since the pre class videos were not sufficient. However, Tyler did a good job always asking us if we had questions or if we needed help. He always was willing to help outside of class which was super nice.</p>
